Warmer weather has finally arrived; the memories of bitterly cold temperatures and snow lay to rest for another season. Here at CCSI however we work diligently year-round to ensure that no individual; no family is left cold and hungry during the harsher months.

Although we've made great strides in combatting homelessness; each of the past five years has brought an increase in the number of families and individuals seeking homeless services. This past season, our strong community partnership provided 8,908 nights of shelter, food, showers, laundry, case management and transportation.

This December 6th we will be holding our Annual Celebration of Hope and Community benefitting our Warm Nights Hypothermia Shelter Program. Warm Night's remains the only hypothermia shelter in the greater Metro DC region that accepts both individuals and families with children.
